INCIDENT: Residential Armed Robbery

DETAILS:

On Sunday, January 20, 2008, at 6:30 p.m., a residential robbery occurred at 4069 Mesa Court Residence Hall. The two suspects were described as male Asians, 18-20 years old, 5'7" to 5'9", medium build, wearing dark bandanas over their faces. One suspect was wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans, and displayed a black handgun.

The second suspect wore a white hooded sweatshirt and faded blue jeans. The suspects accessed the building via unknown means, entered the unlocked room and confronted the three male victims, all UCI students. The suspects lightly bound the victims and demanded money. The suspects went through the room taking a laptop computer, two cell phones, a small amount of cash, some clothes and miscellaneous property. The suspects fled on foot in an unknown direction carrying a blue duffle bag with the stolen property. None of the victims were injured in this incident.

The Police Department has committed substantial resources to investigating this crime and additional resources have been provided by the Irvine Police Department. We are conducting additional patrols in all of our residential areas and our Campus Safety Escort program is available to anyone during the evening hours at (949) 824-SAFE.
