



Residence Hall Property Safety

UC Irvine is a very safe campus, but property crime is still the most common form of crime on campus. You can prevent it.

1. Lock your windows while you are away, especially if you live on the ground floor.
2. Do not loan your key to anyone, even friends.
3. Unlocked rooms with no one inside are a favorite target for thieves. Always lock your room while you are away, even if you are just going to use the restroom or going to the living room to watch TV.
4. Lock your door while you are inside for personal safety.
5. Do not prop open suite or residence doors. Meet visitors at the door.
6. Do not tamper with door locking mechanisms. Never use tape, pins, etc. to keep the door from locking shut.
7. Avoid leaving messages on your door describing your departing or returning times. This can alert potential thieves to your absence.
8. Do not leave large sums of money, jewelry, or valuables in your room. Try keeping them out of sight.
9. Refrain from leaving valuables such as backpacks or laptops in communal areas unattended.
10. Report lost or stolen keys immediately.
11. Be mindful of visitors in the room. Do not allow strangers into your room. If a stranger does enter your room, demand that he/she leave. If he/she refuses, create a commotion and leave quickly.
12. Report suspicious people, including door-to-door salespeople, to UCIPD.
