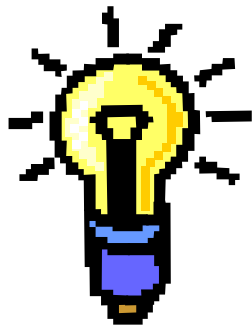


Traveling safely to and from the libraries

Tips to Keeping Your Things Safe

There are many simple steps you can take in keeping your belongings safe while you are in the library. Here are a few:

1. Never have your personal belongings out of sight. If you have to leave the table or area you are at, even if it is to simply go grab a book, take your things with you.
2. Always have your most valuable belongings marked with your student I.D. number, name, and California Drivers License (CDL) number.
3. Keep your eyes open for people who seem to be standing around doing nothing or who continuously walk around where you are studying.

4. Sunday is often a busy day so you should be extra cautious with your belongings.

5. In addition, be aware during midterms and finals when there are a lot of people at the library.

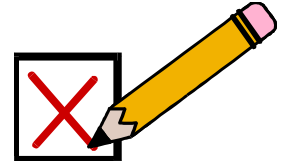
6. If you are going to study, try to use one of the study rooms at the science library because you can lock your belongings inside the room.

NOTE: you must call the library ahead of time to reserve a room. (949) 824-3681.



7. Try to study in groups. Studying with a friend is safer because he or she can keep track of your belongings if you need to leave and it is safer when you walk to and from the libraries.

8. Use an engraver to identify your belongings. You can come to the police station and ask to use the engraver to mark your belongings with your name and Driver's license number. You need your UCI ID card to use it.



9. If you don't want to use the study rooms at the library, you can also reserve the rooms at the UCI Student Center. (949) 824-4349. They can also be locked and secured.
