**Community Advisory:** Vehicle Burglaries

**Date:** August 27, 2024

**Location:** Verano Place Parking Structure

**Details:** UCIPD has received reports of three vehicle burglaries (a 2014 Toyota Prius, a 2016 Toyota Prius, and a 2023 Porsche 911 GT3) in the Verano Parking Structure. The reporting parties stated that their vehicles were burglarized between August 18-22, 2024. The suspect broke into the vehicles by smashing side windows to gain access and stole a dashboard cam, a hybrid battery, a hatchback trunk cover, a radar detector and other miscellaneous items.

UCIPD canvassed the area but was unable to locate any subjects. Should you have information that is helpful to this investigation please contact UCIPD at (949) 824-5223.
