Over the past two weeks UCIPD received reports of thefts from vehicles parked in the University Hills Community and Verano Place Graduate and Family parking lots. Items that have been taken from vehicles were; cash, DMV registration, parking permits, cell phone, skateboard, Nintendo game console, sleeping bag, camping tent, insurance registration, and jewelry. Our detectives are actively investigating the theft reports.

- Ensure that all doors are locked and fully close all windows (including sunroof).
- Never leave purses, wallets, electronics, or other valuables in plain sight.
- Carry the car registration and insurance card with you. Don't leave personal identification documents in the car.
