Necessity




National attention on negative police contacts resulting in animosity and distrust.



OIS, Officer ambushes etc. **2018**: 185 line of duty deaths – 52 death by gunfire; 5 in California **2019**: 147 line of duty deaths – 48 by gunfire; 6 in California.

Duties


- Facilitate briefing visits by UCI guest speakers and community groups to promote partnerships and educational opportunities.
